in Finland.

Late entry fee (after 19.6.) is + 70 €/rider.

Guest riders licence: The rider must present valid membership card or some other proof of

membership of his/hers motorclub issued by SML / National Motorcycle

Federation.

The number of entries: The number of participants is limited to 35 solo competitors and 22 sidecars/

start. Qualifying based on timed practice.

The minimum number of laps (during practice/timed paractice) to be

qualified is 3.

To qualify for the race, a rider must achieve a time during one of the qualifying sessions at least equal to 112 % of the average qualifying time recorded by the fastest 3 riders of his class, Open-, Retro SB-, ICGP-classes

maximum 115 % of the fastest lap time in practice and Sidecars 120 %.

Newcomers: The organizer reserves the right to choose participants for the race. The first

time participating riders must inform this to the organizer upon entry.

Riders briefing: All riders are required to attend the rider's briefing

on Friday at 13.30 p.m. and on Saturday 6.7. at 9.00 a.m.

Protests: All protests must be made to the Clerk of the Course, be in accordance with

the SML rules and be accompanied protest fee 50 € in cash.

Schedule: Preliminary schedule attached to this supplementary regulations.

Technical Inspection: Technical inspection schedule in the paddock:

Thursday 3.7. at 12.00 – 21.00, Friday 4.7. at 8.00 – 13.00 and

Saturday 5.7. at 8.00 – 13.00.

The highest level of noise measured should be 107db/A according the SML

Regulations.

Paddock: All riders must use an environment mats under bikes and cars. All riders must

have a fire extinguisher the minimum type is a 6 kg. The fire extinguisher must be easily accessible and ready available. Follow the speed limits in paddock area. Burning rubber on a motorcycle is strictly forbiddden in the whole

paddock area.

Notice: Access to the paddock area is free for public:

Friday 4.7. at 15.00 - 21.00, Saturday 5.7. at 9.00 - 21.00 and Sunday 6.7. at 9.00 - 18.00. There must be paddock pass and car pass visibly placed in

each vehicle.

Confirmation: Rider will receive confirmation and other information by email. Remember

Other regulations: The competition must comply with circuit safety regulations approved by the

Finnish Motorcycling Federation's board on May 14, 2025.

In case of heavy rain, the start will be stopped. In other situations, the jury and race management will decide wheather to continue the race/ practices,

talking into account the safety of the wet circuit.
